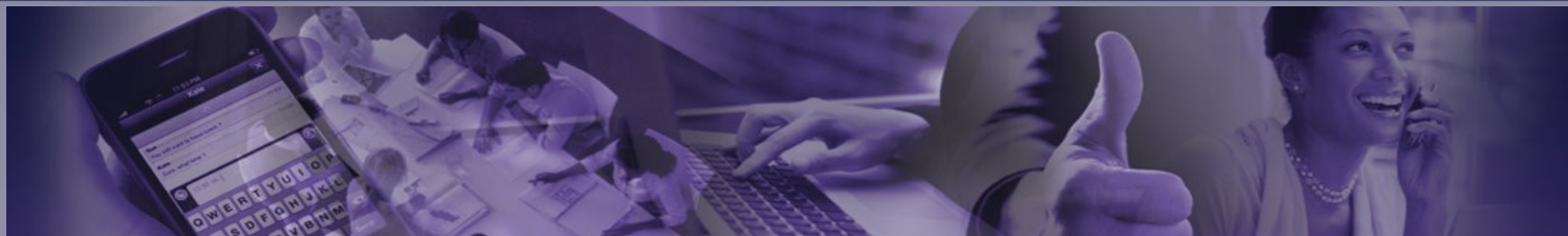


... and sometimes an extra pair of eyes IS the problem.
